We are delighted to announce that we will be having a zoom Question and Answer chat with Dr Katerina Vezyroglou on **Friday 27th November at 8pm (GMT)** on her research 'AHC and ATP1A3 Natural History study'.

Many of you will be aware that Dr Katerina Vezyroglou is a senior Paediatric Neurology Registrar and Clinical Research Fellow undertaking her PhD on AHC. She is based at Great Ormond Street Hospital and works closely with Professor Helen Cross, Professor Sanjay Sisodiya and Dr Simona Balestrini undertaking research into AHC and ATP1A3 diseases.



If you are unsure what her study is about; would like to know how it could help your child/family member or patient; or how you can get involved with it, or if you're already enrolled but have new questions to ask her then this Question-and-Answer zoom session will cover the key parts of the study that you need to know about.
